## Community Development and Public Works will be having a centralized NEIGHBORHOOD CLEAN-UP DAY.

Residents of the City of Norcross can drop off any bulky items, trash, old appliances/furniture and any other accumulated trash or unwanted items. Solvent or hazardous material (batteries, paint, large car parts, motor, tires, oil, anti-freeze, concrete, household chemicals and similar items) **WILL NOT BE ALLOWED.**

Items must be of reasonable size and environmentally safe in order to be disposed of properly.

**If you have a large vehicle that can be used for hauling, think of organizing a group to help your neighbors, (especially the elderly).**

We will also have a run-off dumpster for recyclables only. We will accept the same type items you put out with your weekly recyclables – plastic, paper, cardboard, aluminum, phone books, and similar items. Recyclable items must be separate from the other items you are discarding.

Join us on the same day for our **“CAN” Do for Hunger Campaign!** Clean out your pantry and bring non-perishable food items to be donated to our local food banks and given to members of our community in need. We are asking all participants to bring a canned or non-perishable goods to support the **2013 “CAN” Do for Hunger Campaign.** Donations will be accepted at each clean-up/recycling location
