

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Norcross Incentive Package Programs and Partnerships encourage development and new growth.



The Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) establishes LDCT annual data from The United States Department of Labor and The United States Department of Commerce.

Job Tax Credits are available in LDCT's by developing at least five full-time jobs. Employers may receive a tax credit of \$3,500 per year, for 5 years.

2012 is the first year Gwinnett County has implemented LDCT's but the existence of LDCT's dates back to 2007.

The DCA designates a LDCT based on the criteria put forth by law; it is not the same as an Opportunity Zone.






## The following business types are acceptable for job credits under a LDCT:

Manufacturing, warehousing & distribution, processing center, telecommunications, broadcasting, research & development or tourism. Retail is not indicated as an acceptable business to receive this job credit.

New jobs must be offered with health insurance, employer does not have to pay for such insurance, just offer it.

More than 50% of the city is within the Less Developed Census Tract and we are one of the only cities in the county to have the incentive.
