

# Call for Applications: Boards, Commissions & Authorities

The City of Norcross is inviting qualified individuals to apply to serve on a variety of its Boards, Commissions, and Authorities (BCAs).

Interested individuals should review the preferred qualifications and complete the appointment application. In addition to the written application, candidates must submit a brief video recording to finalize the application packet. Instructions for the video submission are included in the appointment application.

Applicants are encouraged to research the BCA to which they are applying to better understand its role, responsibilities, and impact. Please note that some BCAs may require additional steps in the selection process, such as interviews or attendance at meetings, to provide candidates with a clearer perspective on the board's function.

Discovery Garden Park Board (DGP) application packets are due **Wednesday, October 15, at 5:00 p.m.**

Downtown Development Authority (DDA), Norcross Public Arts Commission (NPAC), and Norcross Housing Authority (NHA) application packets are due **Friday, October 31, at 5:00 p.m.**

## Downtown Development Authority of Norcross (DDA)

Ideal applicants are individuals who:

- Are residents or business owners within the City of Norcross
- Bring experience in commercial real estate, development, or brokerage
- Have a background in financial services, banking, or investment management
- Demonstrate expertise in business development, entrepreneurship, or business retention
- Possess strong community connections and a commitment to supporting Norcross's downtown growth
- Are enthusiastic about fostering economic vitality, strategic redevelopment, and vibrant local business opportunities
